

How to file a National Patent Application (via Paris Convention Route)

The applicant must, at least, complete these requirements as minimum filing requirements.

- 1. File a completed Form 1 together with the prescribed fee of PG K1,000.00;
- 2. Provide a official letter (notice) requesting for grant of a patent together with prescribed requirements;
- 3. Complete description of the invention that is inclusive of but not limited to;
 - a. Claims:
 - b. Figures, drawings, graphs, sequence listings etc and;
 - c. Abstract.
- 4. Attach a completed **Power of Attorney form**;
- 5. Where the applicant is not the inventor, attach a <u>Statement Justifying the Applicant's Right</u> in the prescribed format;
- 6. Submit three (3) copies each of the documents mentioned in item 3 of this document.

NOTE:

- It must be furnished in accordance with the physical format as prescribed in <u>'Physical Requirements as to Form'</u> & <u>'Formality requirements for filing an Application</u>.
- For purpose of **claiming protection over a priority application** in another country, filing with the office must be done within **12 months of filing the first application**.
